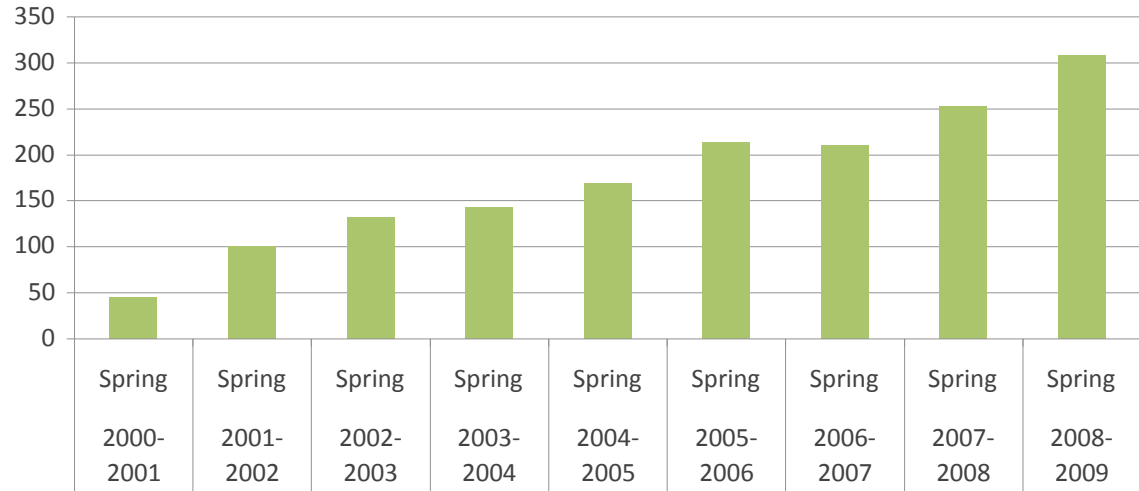

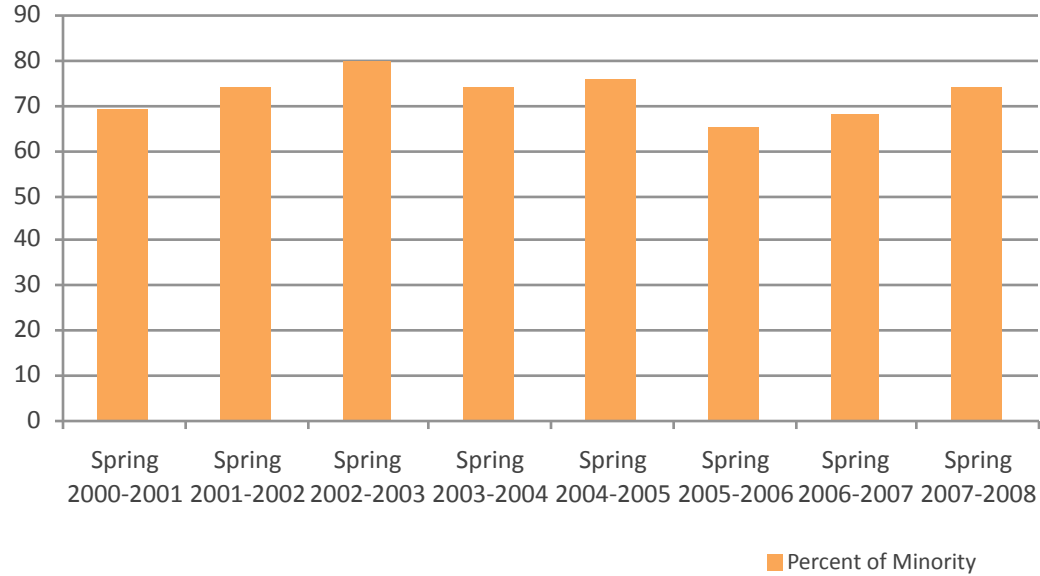

Percent of Minority



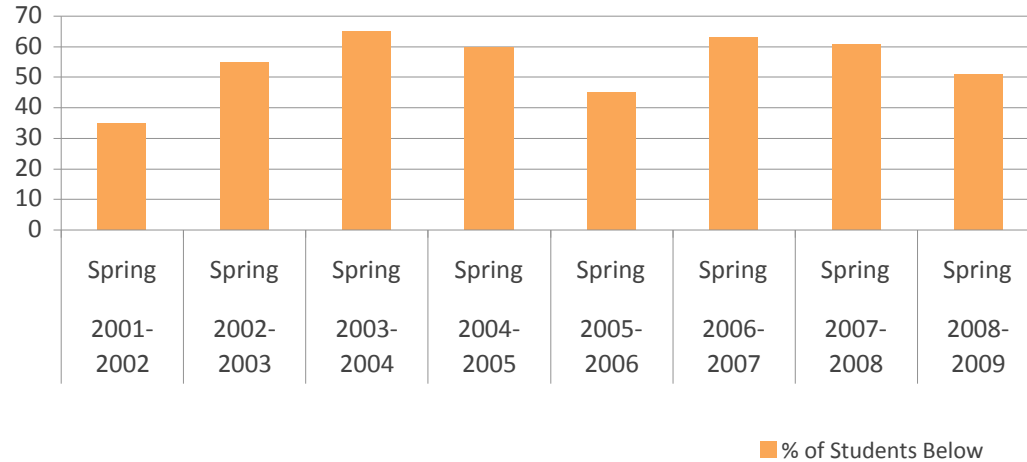

Percent Poverty Level of Students



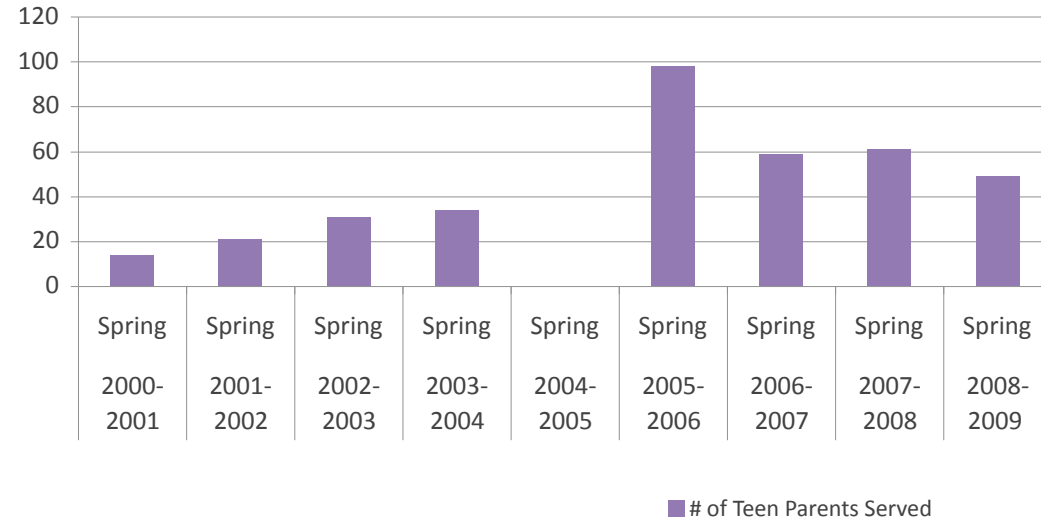

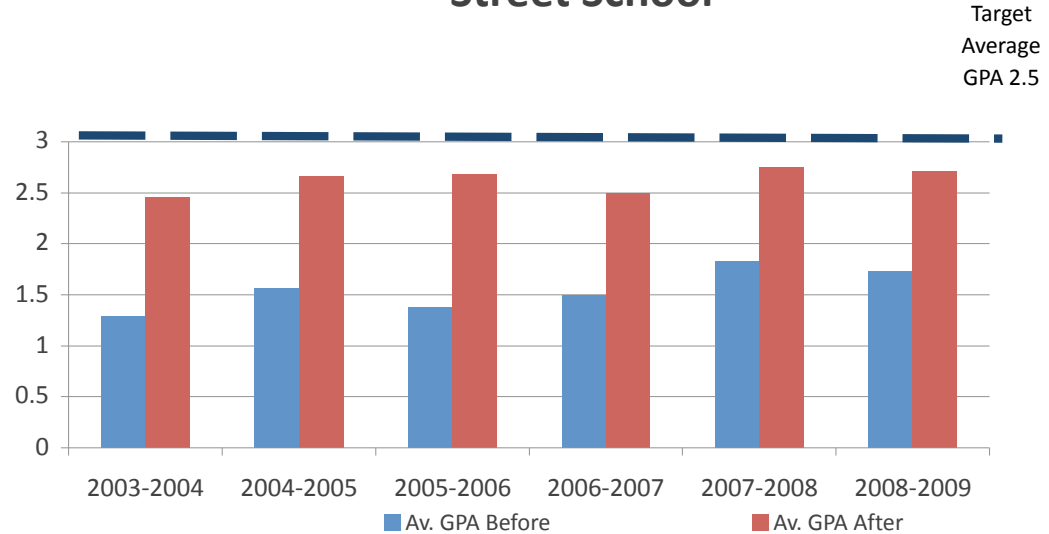

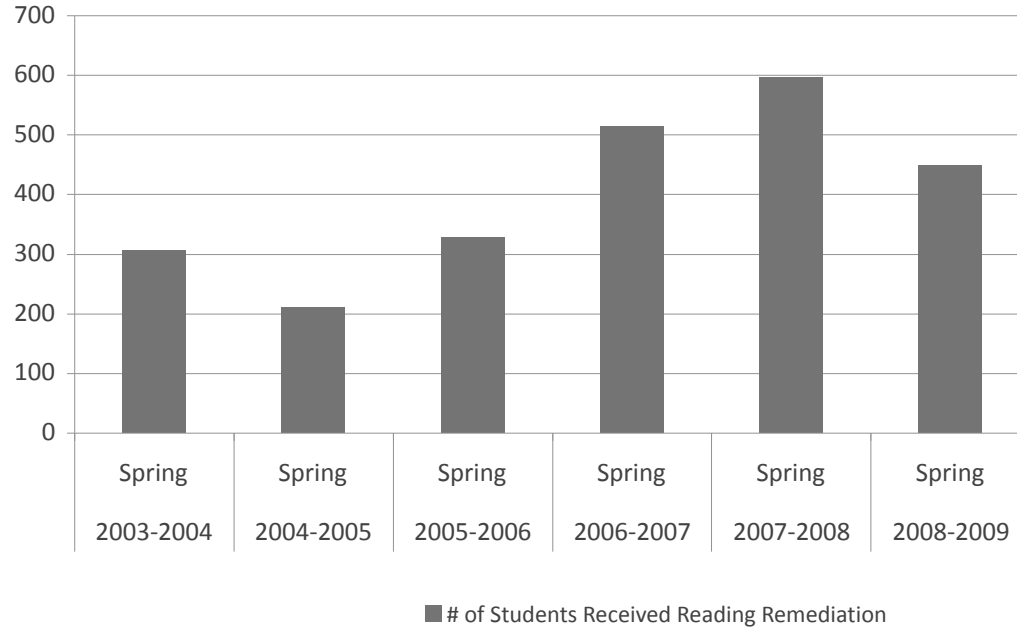

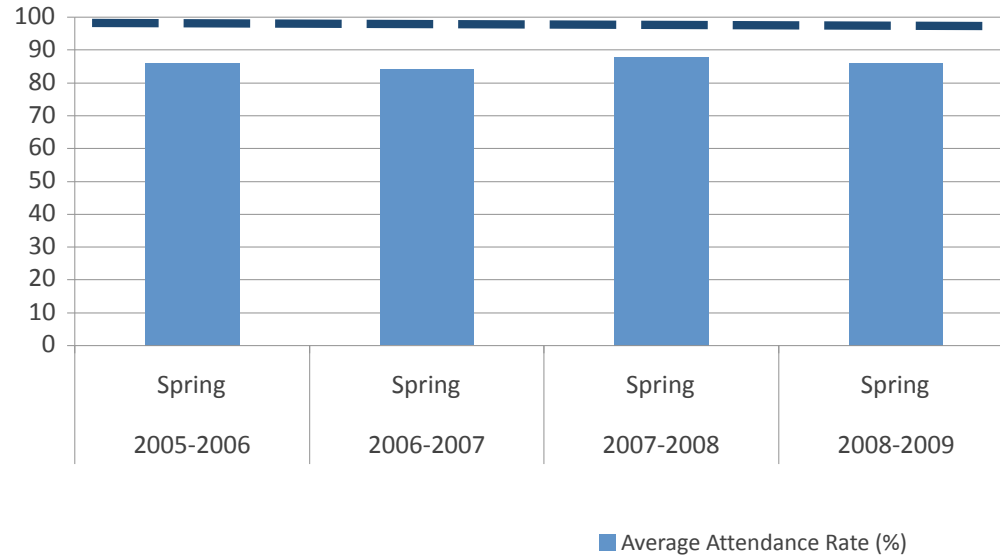

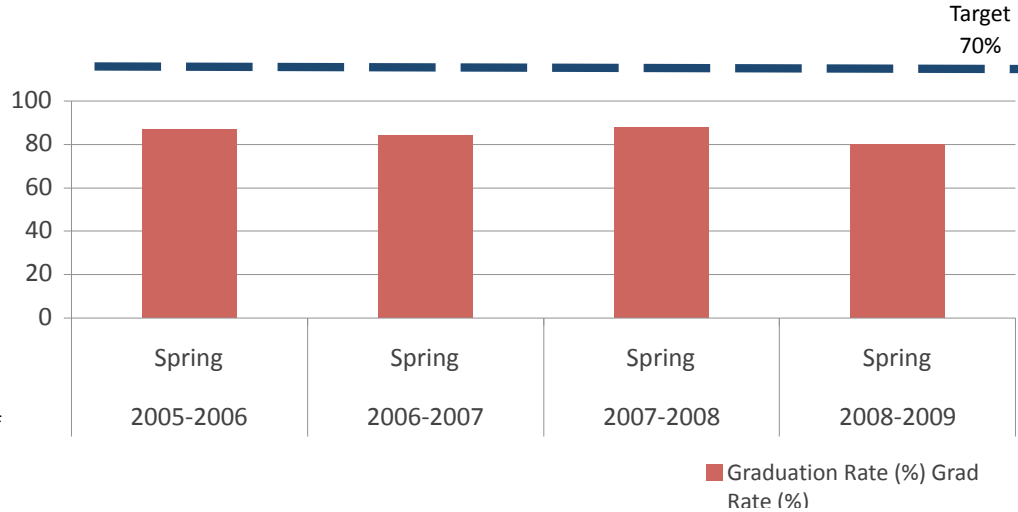

Average Post-Secondary Enrollment Rate (%)

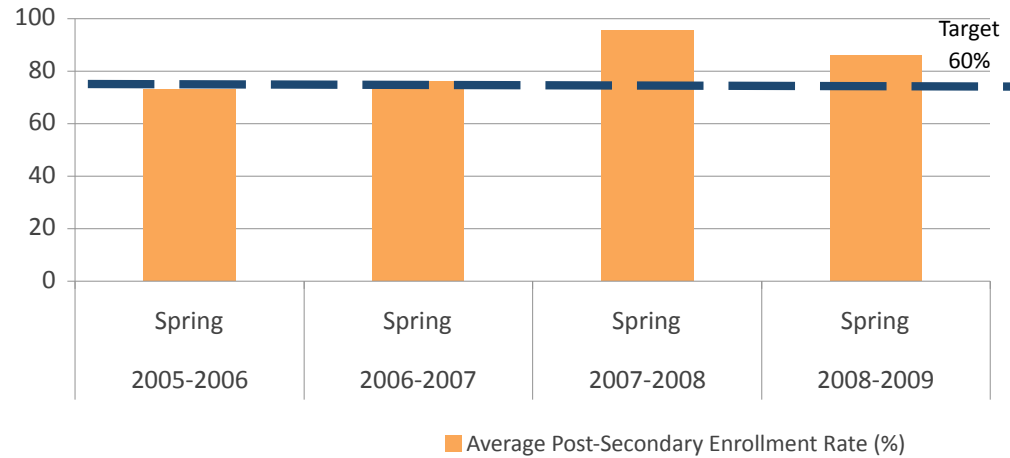

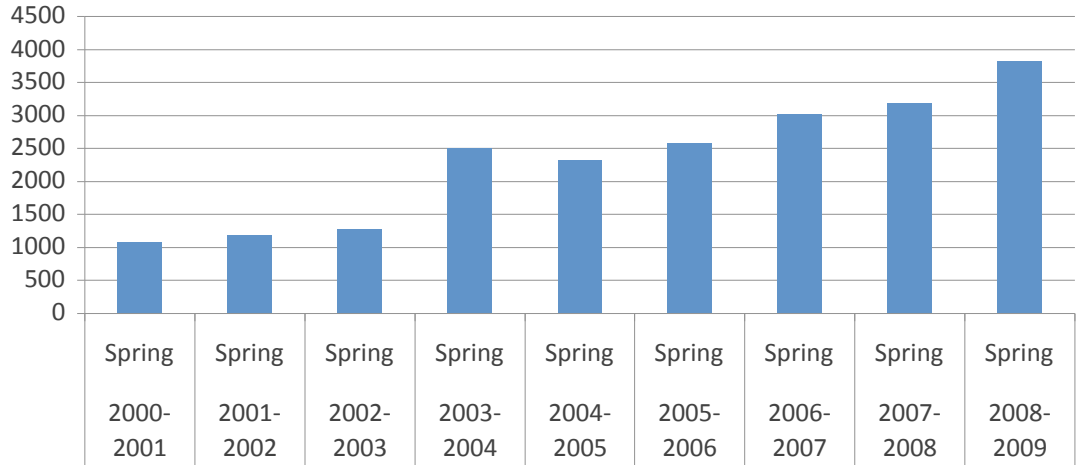

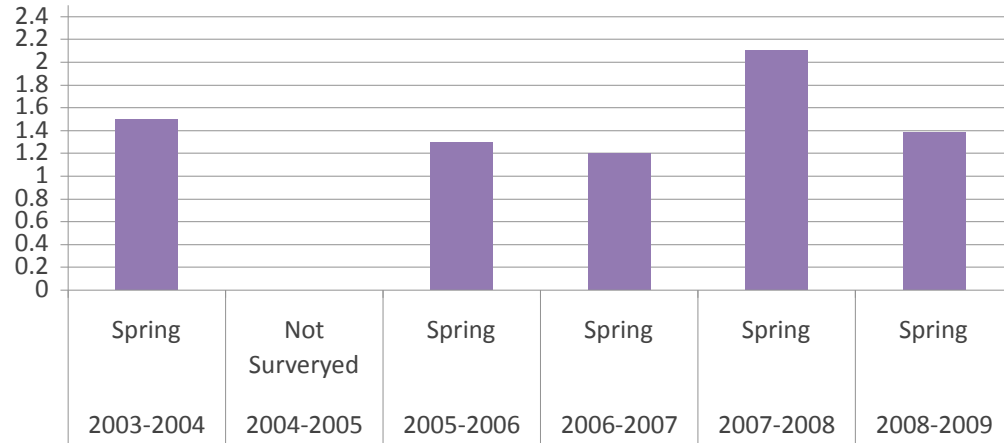

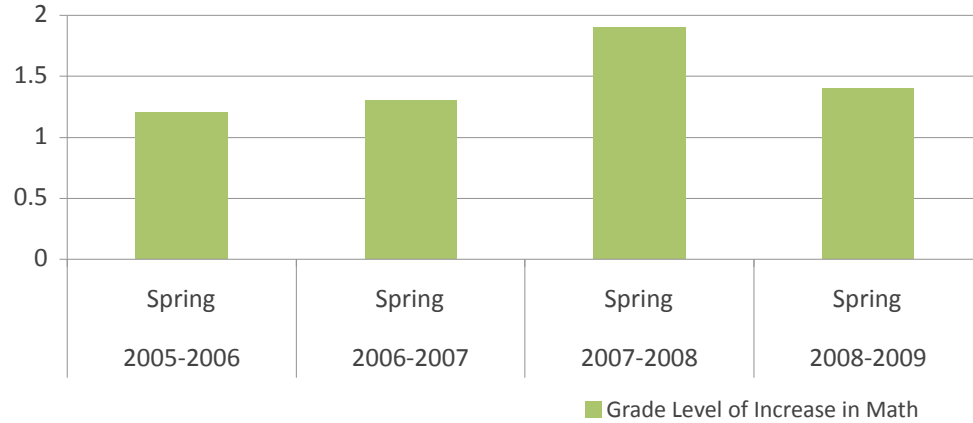
